

Resolution 09-05

TITLE: Term Limits – Regional Vice Presidents

BYLAW/STANDING RULE AFFECTED: Article II, Section 2,C.

CURRENT BYLAW/STANDING RULE: No current provisions for term limits on Regional Vice Presidents

IF ADOPTED: Add to Article II, Section 2C1. “No person elected to the position of Regional Vice President shall serve more than three (3) two (2) year terms.”

REASON CHANGE SHOULD BE ADOPTED: This change would possibly encourage NARFE members to get more involved in the organization and possibly seek this position knowing that their current Regional VP will be limited to the number of terms that they could serve. There are many qualified NARFE members that are hesitant to seek election to offices when there is an incumbent due to the fact that “Old Joe” (or “Old Jane”) has been serving. But more importantly, when there are new members being elected to the NEB, that brings the benefit of new ideas being brought to the NEB Meetings.
